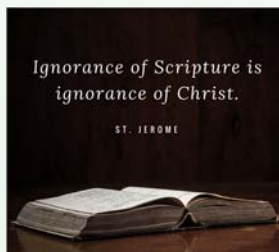

(4:00 pm – 5:15 pm) for **Grades K - 5th**

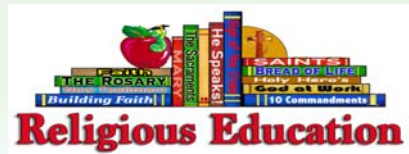
